#### What is Accreditation?

- The Cambridge Dictionary defines Accreditation as the fact of being officially recognized, accepted, or approved of, or the act of officially recognizing, accepting, or approving of something.
- Wikipedia defines Accreditation as an independent, third-party evaluation
  of a conformity assessment body (such as a certification body) against
  recognized standards, conveying formal demonstration of its impartiality
  and competence to carry out specific conformity assessment tasks (such as
  certification)
- Accreditation holds higher significance to stakeholders and clients

### What is ANAB?



- ANSI is the official United States member of the International Organization for Standardization (ISO)
- The International Organization for Standardization (ISO) is the world's largest developer and publisher of International Standards. ISO is a network of the national standards institutes of 164 countries, one member per country, with a Central Secretariat in Geneva, Switzerland, that coordinates the system. ISO is a non-governmental organization that forms a bridge between the public and private sectors.
- ISO does NOT issue certifications, they write standards, which third-party accreditors then
  use to assess businesses and programs like the Vibration Institute's Vibration Analyst
  Certification Program
- ANAB ANSI National Accreditation Board is <u>internationally recognized</u> and meets the highest standards for accrediting institutions. Respected worldwide, ANAB is the largest accreditation body serving North America, as well as programs based in other countries.

Since its launch in 2003, our personnel certification accreditation program based on the international standard <u>ISO/IEC 17024:2012</u>, Conformity assessment - General requirements for bodies operating certification of persons, has helped certification programs make the journey from good to great.



### What value do Vibration Institute certified Vibration Analysts receive from the program's ANAB Accreditation to ISO/IEC 17024?

- The ANAB symbol signals to an employer that the Vibration Institute has undergone a valid, fair, and reliable assessment to verify that they have the necessary competencies to practice.

- The accountability and transparency built into the ANAB process support conformity assessment attestations and can result in reduced liability insurance.







- ANAB's international involvement and recognition saves time and money for ANAB-accredited certification bodies looking to expand into international markets.



 The Vibration Institute vibration analyst certification program is the benchmark and is known as one of the highest recognitions of industry knowledge and competence among professionals in the field.
 Our certification program is the only vibration analyst certification program accredited by the ANSI National Accreditation Board (ANAB)
 Our training courses are entirely separate from our certification. However, Vibration Institute training courses meet the training requirements for CAT I-CAT IV vibration analyst certification exams per ISO 18436-2:2014



- Anyone can offer a certification exam and claim it meets the standards for ISO 18436-2 vibration analyst certification
- While other individuals and companies certify other individuals in the industry, no legal requirements regulate these companies or individuals. That's where an accreditation body's role, such as ANAB comes into play.
- The Institute is audited annually by ANAB in order to assure continued conformance in meeting ISO/IEC 17024, ISO 18436-1 and ISO 18436-2 certification requirements




# Certification Process at the Vibration Institute

Requirements for each level of Certification,
Category I-IV

- Meet the work experience requirement
- Meet the vibration training requirement (Register for a vibration training course if needed. If you're not located in the US, please contact one of our International Representatives)
- Register for your exam
- Complete your exam application (must be submitted & approved in advance of your exam)
- Receive your exam results by email within 3 weeks of your exam date.
- In 5 years, recertify (ISO standards require recertification either by re-examination or providing evidence of continued work experience and ongoing qualifying professional development to assure continued competence)
