Requirements to Sit for (Take) a Certification Examination: The Vibration Institute vibration analyst certification conforms to the International Standard ISO 18436-2:2014 Condition monitoring and diagnostics of machines – Requirements for qualification and assessment of personnel, Part 2: Vibration condition monitoring and diagnostics. Note: References below to Section numbers (e.g., Section 5.3.1) refer to section numbers in ISO 18436-2:2014 unless otherwise stated.

To be eligible for assessment, per ISO Standards, candidates:

- shall provide documentary evidence of qualified training in vibration analysis and condition monitoring
- shall provide evidence of qualified experience in vibration analysis and condition monitoring
- shall be certified at the previous level unless they qualify for mature (direct) candidate entry into Category II or Category III

Documented relevant training and experience are required to sit for the Vibration Institute's Vibration Analyst Certification Examinations. The minimum required training and experience are shown in the table below:
