**Requirements to Sit for (Take) a Certification Examination:** The Vibration Institute vibration analyst certification conforms to the International Standard ISO 18436-2:2014 Condition monitoring and diagnostics of machines – Requirements for qualification and assessment of personnel, Part 2: Vibration condition monitoring and diagnostics. Note: References below to Section numbers (e.g., Section 5.3.1) refer to section numbers in ISO 18436-2:2014 unless otherwise stated.

## To be eligible for assessment, per ISO Standards, candidates:

- · shall provide documentary evidence of qualified training in vibration analysis and condition monitoring
- shall provide evidence of qualified experience in vibration analysis and condition monitoring
- · shall be certified at the previous level unless they qualify for mature (direct) candidate entry into Category II or Category III
